How To Bring An Army To A Halt

The thing that is shown here is made of a single piece of wrought iron cut in the shape of a

four pointed star. Each 'cross-arm' measures four and one-quarter inches from tip to tip. Each cross-arm is bent in a semicircle that perpendicular to other. The the resulting object,



no matter how it is positioned on a flat surface, rests on three of the tips with the fourth one pointing straight up in the air.

The thing shown here is what was known as a *caltrop*. The caltrop was considered an antipersonnel and anti-horse weapon. A number of them would be scattered over a road, trail or in a streambed over which enemy troops would be bound to travel. Men who would step on one of these passive weapons would be instantly disabled. They might be able to continue on, but

they would be in quite a bit of pain. A horse that



would step on a caltrop would not only be disabled itself, but it would probably flinch or jerk violently, throwing its rider. Although the man or horse would not be permanently disabled,

their progress would be hindered.

The name *caltrop* is derived from the Latin, *calcitrapa*, meaning 'foot trap.' The weapon was also known by the names: caltrap, galtrop, galtrap, calthrop, jackrock and crow's foot. The caltrop was used since ancient Roman times, during the American Revolutionary War, and right up to the present time. They were used extensively during both World Wars. And even today, police departments use a variation of the caltrop to puncture pneumatic tires.

I'll bring the caltrop along to the June 3rd meeting. You can see it in person if you come to the meeting.
