About This List

The chapters of this book are not titled: *Bedford County Soldiers in the American Revolutionary War*, *Blair County Soldiers in the American Revolutionary War*, *Fulton County Soldiers in the American Revolutionary War* and *Huntingdon County Soldiers in the American Revolutionary War*. Those are not the titles for a very simple reason: they might not seem to be, but they are ambiguous.

So what is confusing about the titles noted above? The “*in the American Revolutionary War*” part is not what is ambiguous about the titles. All of the soldiers listed can be identified between the dates of 19 April 1775 and 26 November 1783. Rather, it is the “*Bedford County Soldiers*” part that is what is difficult to easily identify. ~ What makes any particular individual a ‘Bedford County’ soldier as compared to any other county’s soldier? And can a ‘Bedford County’ soldier also be a ‘Blair County’ soldier?

Using the present-day county of Bedford for example, whose names would a list of ‘Bedford County Soldiers’ include? Does that title suggest the names of just the individuals who were born in Bedford County ~ native sons ~ who became soldiers? Or does that title suggest the names of just the

individuals who resided for any length of time in Bedford County ~ residents ~ whether before or after serving in the armed forces? And further yet, does that title suggest the names of just the individuals who died in and were buried in Bedford County, whether they were native sons, or if they came to reside there after they served in the armed forces?

To take the point just a step further, what about any soldiers who might have come into Bedford County to garrison a fortification for three months? Did they have any ties to the region for which they should be remembered? For example, should General Daniel Roberdeau be honored in the history of present-day county of Blair? Although he was not born here, although he did not reside here for any appreciable length of time and although he did not die and be laid to rest here, his fleeting presence in this region was of some importance.

Rather than try to compile a list Patriots to whom any single one of those options applied, it was decided to include all of them. The titles were adjusted to suggest inclusion of any Patriot who had any ties to the county during the American Revolutionary War.
