Madam:

I have to advise you that from the papers in the Revolutionary War pension claim S. 2042 it appears that John Lane was born February 22, 2756 in Baltimore County, Maryland.

While a resident of Bedford County, Pennsylvania he enlisted April 1, 1779 and served nine months as scout and Indian Spy in Captain Thomas Cluggage's Pennsylvania Company.

He enlisted the following springand served six months as Indian-Spy in Captain William Philips' Pennsylvania Company.

After the Revolution he moved to Marydand, place not stated, and lived eight or nine years and then returned to Bedford County, Pennsylvania. He was allowed pension on his application executed November 27, 1832 while a resident of Hopewell Township, in said Bedford County. It is not stated action of the one interest whether he was ever married.
