I do not recollect during my service of any Regular or Militia Regiments being encamped with us, but several times we were encamped with companies of Militia of which companies the above named officers had some other than command.

6<sup>th</sup> Did you ever receive a discharge from the service if so, by whom was it given & what has become of it?

Answer - I never received any discharge, I received certificates for my services from the Comptroller General of Pennsylvania (John Dickinson), which I had to use at a road fare
