due up to the day of his death have been paid.
The said John Hutchinson died at his residence
in Barren Township, Huntingdon County, on
the 11th day of February 1827, of which proof
was made by this deponent to the War Depart-
ment as also of the fact of her being the widow
of the said John Hutchinson about the year
A.D. 1828 or 1829 in order to enable her to draw
the arrears of pension due her said hus-
band at the time of his death on 11th February
A.D. 1827.

She further declares that she was married
to the said John Hutchinson on the second day
of October A.D. seventeen hundred and eighty
nine, in the County of Chester in the State of
Pennsylvania as more fully and at large
appears by the accompanying marriage
certificate of Abel Griffith who was a min-
ister of the Baptist Church, which certificate
was delivered into the hands of this de-
ponent on the day of her marriage by the said
minister, and of which she from that time has
retained the possession. That her said husband
died 11th Febby 1827 - that she was not married to
him prior to his leaving the service, but the mar-
riage took place previous to the first of January
seventeen hundred and ninety four, viz, on
the day and year above written, the 2nd October
A.D. 1794.
