Alexander King being duly sworn before the subscriber
an Associate Judge of the Court of Common Pleas for said County doth depose and say
that he enlisted on the tenth day of January 1776 at New London Corp Roads
in Chester County Pennsylvania with Captain Henry Derby in the Delaware
Regiment commanded by Colonel Hazlet for the term of one year during
which term deponent was in the battle of Long Island White Plains in which he
received a slight wound in the hand from the Bayonet of a Hessian and
continued in said Regiment thro' the Jersey's and was at the taking of the
Hessians at the Battle of Trenton. That he returned home to Chester County
aforesaid in January 1777 the term for which he enlisted having expired. That
deponent again enlisted in Chester County aforesaid at the Corp Roads in the Spring
of 1777 with Lieutenant William Henderson in Captain Benjamin Bushbowers
Company 11th Pennsylvania Regiment on the Continental establishment com-
manded by Lieutenant Colonel B. William Butler Com'd' during the war as a
Corporal and afterwards served as a Sergeant. That during the last mentioned
enlistment he was at the Battle of Brandywine and Germantown, and
shortly after the Battle of Monmouth the said Regiment was detached to Scho-
hare where he wintered and in the following summer joined General Sulli-
van at the Mouth of the Susquehanna, on his expedition against the Indians thro'
the Seneca Country and after that expedition was once joined the main
Army and remained in the service until January 1781 during the latter per-
iod he had several severe attacks of sickness which rendered him unfit
for further service, on which account he obtained his discharge and re-
turned to his family. And deponent further saith that neither he or
any person for him ever received any donation Lands or Pensions from the
United States on account of his services aforesaid and deponent further
saith that from his reduced circumstances he needs the assistance of his
Country for support and should he be entitled to a Pension under
any former law of Congress or the United States he doth hereby entirely
and fully release the same to the United States.
